

JUPITER MAN SURVIVES HIT FROM LIGHTNING

John Huston of Tarpon Springs and Tom Cleaver of Tampa share the lead entering today's final round of the \$65,500 Florida Open, but Hunt Gilliland of Jupiter was the lucky one Saturday.

Gilliland was hit by lightning while he was putting his clubs in his car. He got up and reported the incident, saying his left side and left arm were numb. Gilliland was taken to Tarpon Springs Hospital for observation and was released. He withdrew from the tournament after an eight-over-par 80.

Huston (72) and **Cleaver** (67) are at five-under 211, three strokes ahead of James Weeden of Deerfield Beach (72), Bobby Dick of Tallahassee (70) and Frank Reynolds of Naples (70).
